The Ticket to Dream Scholarship program offers up to three \$1,000 Top Awards + up to five \$500 Runner-up Scholarships annually to graduating seniors who attend high school in a specific region of service limited to the following Ohio Counties:

Clark, Darke, Greene, Miami, Montgomery and Preble.

Scholarships are only awarded to students with plans to pursue post-secondary education who reside in a single parent household.

The Ticket to Dream Scholarship program defines children in single-parent families as any child who lives with a single parent: Specifically,

A Head of Household (Mom, Dad, Grandparent, Uncle or Aunt)

who is unmarried, widowed, or divorced and not remarried.

(According to the Pew Research Center, approximately 25 percent of children in the U.S.

live in a single-parent household.)

Students who apply MUST be graduating seniors and meet the residency requirement.
